CLASS XI ADMISSION GUIDELINES - 2026

Imphal, the May, 2026

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSIONS:

The Selection of candidates for admission to **Class XI (Science, Arts, and Commerce)** for the academic session **2026–27** shall be made strictly on the basis of the merit list of the Entrance Test to be conducted by the school.

All students seeking admission to Tamphasana Girls' Higher Secondary School, Imphal, must register through online at: <http://tghss.ac.in>

The reservations for OBC, OBC(MP), SC, ST, SPORTS, IDP, PWD and Staff Children shall be as per norms set by the school Admission Committee 2026.

1. ONLINE REGISTRATION:

A student shall be eligible for registration if she has passed the HSLC or an equivalent examination in **2026** and fulfils the following criteria:

NOTES:

- i. In case of shortage of applicants in any category, the vacant seats shall be added to the UR category.
- ii. Candidates may apply for more than one stream:
 - (a) Science.
 - (b) Arts or Commerce.
- iii. For CBSE and other boards, the eligibility percentage of marks shall be calculated based on **all subjects in which the student has appeared** in the examination:
 - (a) If a student appears in **6 subjects**, the percentage shall be calculated on the basis of **all 6 subjects**.
 - (b) If a student appears in **5 subjects**, the percentage shall be calculated on the basis of **all 5 subjects**.

2. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO BE UPLOADED FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION:

1. Mark Sheet of HSLC or equivalent examination .
2. Admit card of HSLC or equivalent examination.
3. Recent colour passport photo of the candidate.
4. Signature of the candidate.

5. Category (OBC/OBC(MP)/SC/ST/IDP/PWD/SPORTS) certificate.

3. REGISTRATION FEE:

A sum of Rs 200/- only is to be paid at the time of online registration.

4. DATE OF ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Online registration portal will remain open from **9th May to 12th May, 2026.**

5. DATE AND TIME OF ENTRANCE TEST:

Entrance Test will be conducted on **Friday, the 15th May, 2026.**

6. ADMIT CARD FOR ENTRANCE TEST:

Admit Card for Entrance Test can be downloaded from the “**Already Registered**” link of the school website.

NOTE: No candidate will be allowed to appear in the Entrance Test without Admit Card.

7. VENUE OF ENTRANCE TEST:

Examination Centres will be notified separately as per candidates’ Roll Numbers on the school website: <http://tghss.ac.in> , and through local newspapers — POKNAPHAM (Manipuri Edition), SANGAI EXPRESS (English Edition) and HUEIYEN LANPAO.

8. ENTRANCE TEST:

The Entrance Test will consist of **100 multiple-choice questions (MCQs)**, each carrying **4 marks**, distributed as follows:

The questions will be set based on the Class X syllabus of the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur.

The duration of the examination will be 2 hours.

NOTE: There will be NEGATIVE mark for incorrect answer.

1. **+4 marks** for each correct answer
2. **-1 mark** for each incorrect answer

9. ENTRANCE TEST RESULTS:

The merit list of the selected candidates will be declared on the same day as the Entrance Test. The results will be uploaded on the school website: <http://tghss.ac.in> and will also be available at the School Notice Board.

TIE-BREAKING RULE:

If two or more students obtain equal marks in the Entrance Test, the marks secured in the HSLC or equivalent examination shall be used to break the tie, as follows:

1. **For Science Stream:**

Priority will be given in the following order of higher marks obtained in:

Science → Mathematics → English → MIL

2. **For Arts and Commerce Streams:**

Priority will be given in the following order of higher marks obtained in:

Social Science → Mathematics → English → MIL

NOTE:

- i. **In case of a further tie, the tie shall be decided by a lottery.**

- ii. **The Admission Committee has decided that the Grade Points obtained in the HSLC or any equivalent examination shall be converted into nominal percentage of mark in a subject using the formula = Grade Point in the subject x 9.5 , as shown below:**

10. ADMISSION:

Admission of selected candidates from the Entrance Test will be conducted from the day following the declaration of results i.e., **16th May 2026**, starting from **10:00 AM**. Candidates must be accompanied by their parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any selected candidate who fails to complete admission within the stipulated period shall be cancelled the right to admission. Any vacancy arising as a result will be filled from the subsequent merit list, strictly in order of merit.

11. SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

The following documents (**self-attested**) should be submitted at the time of admission:

1. Xerox copy of the Admit Card of Entrance Test.
2. Xerox copy of Provisional certificate of passing HSLC or equivalent examination.
3. Xerox copy of Mark Sheet of HSLC or equivalent examination
4. Xerox copy of Admit Card of HSLC or equivalent examination
5. Xerox copy of Category (OBC/OBC(MP)/SC/ST/IDP/PWD/SPORTS) certificate.

12. FEE STRUCTURE:

The detailed admission fee structure will be available at the school office in due course.

13. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:

The school admission committee reserve the right to cancel the admission of any candidate if the information furnished by the candidate is found to be incorrect or if any submitted documents are found to be forged or fake. Once admitted, fees shall not be refunded.

14. CHANGE OF STREAM:

Change of stream from one discipline to another shall not be permitted under any circumstances. However, in the event of any vacancy in the **Commerce stream**, candidates who have appeared in the Entrance Test for either the Science or Arts stream may be considered for admission against such vacancies, subject to submission of an application to the Admission Committee.

15. STAFF CHILDREN:

Children of teaching and non- teaching staff will be granted direct admission under the UR category of each stream.

16. RESERVATION CRITERIA UNDER SPORTS CATEGORY:

Reservation shall be granted only to candidates who fulfil the following conditions:

1. The applicant must have participated in an International/National-level sports/games competition.
2. The competition must be recognized/organized/approved by a National Sports Federation/ Council/Committees/Associations or approved by the Department of Youth Affairs and Sports, Govt. of Manipur or approved by Indian Olympic Association.
3. The candidate must submit valid documentary proof (certificate/medal record) issued by the concerned authority.

NOTES:

- i. Priority will be given to applicant who won medals (**Gold** → **Silver** → **Bronze**) in case of tie in marks secured in the Entrance Test.
- ii. The decision of the School Admission Committee regarding eligibility and selection under the Sports category shall be final and binding.

17. SUBJECT COMBINATIONS OFFERED IN THE SCHOOL:

1. English and MIL (Manipur/Alternative English/Hindi) are compulsory for all students.
2. Any 4 (four) subjects from the following:

NOTE:

- i. For the Arts stream, admission to Group A, Group B, Group C, or Group D shall be made on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ii. Change of subject combination shall not be permitted under any circumstances in future.
